Ladies Day. We will meet in room G112 (across from the mailboxes) at 9am. This meeting is open to anyone who would like to help.

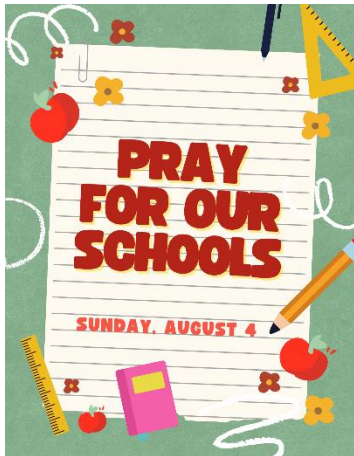

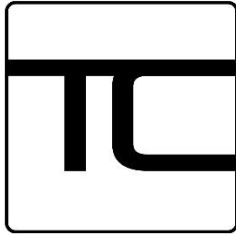


**Kidney Needed**
